Ordinance to Amend Section 10-1-12(b) Regarding Speed Limits on Town Roads

No. 2012-04-16B

Whereas The Town Board of the Town of Warren, St. Croix County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under Wisconsin Statute § 349.11 to adopt speed restrictions that vary from Wisconsin's statutory speed limits, and

Whereas the current version of Section 10-1-12(b) of the Town Ordinances purports to set speed limits but fails to do so, and

Whereas the Town enacted an ordinance "Title 17 – Speed Limits" on December 21, 2009 setting the speed limit on 89th Avenue in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼ of NE ¼) of Section 20, Township 29 North, Range 18 West at twenty-five (25) miles per hour.


Therefore, the Town Board of the Town of Warren does hereby amend Section 10-1-12 of the Town's ordinances to read as follows:

Sec. 10-1-12 Speed Limits.

- a) Authority. The Town Board of the Town of Warren has specific statutory authority, powers and duties, pursuant to the specific statutory section noted in the Section and/o by its adoption of Village powers under Sec. 60.10 Wis. stats., to establish, regulate, control and enforce speed limits in the Town of Warren.
- b) Speed Restrictions. The Town Board of the Town of Warren adopts Sec. 346.57 Wis. Stats., and the speed restrictions contained therein except as specifically provided herein.
- c) The following zoned and posted speed limits which establish limits less than the statutory limits of the Wisconsin Statutes shall be:
 - a. The speed limit on 89th Avenue in the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE ¼ of NE ¼) of Section 20, Township 29 North, Range 18 West at twenty-five (25) miles per hour.
 - b. [insert here any other special limits.]
- d) Penalties. The penalty provisions of Sec. 346.60 Wis. Stats. are adopted herein by reference and are applicable to violations of this Section.

This ordinance shall be effective upon publication or posting by the town clerk as required, pursuant to s. 60.80, Wis. Stat.
